What motivates Paul? The “fear of the Lord” (vs 11) and the “love of Christ” (14a).

Apr 3, Wed

2 Cor 5: 16-21

Birthday: Paul Senkungu, Joseph Thomas

Because we are a new “creation”, we are “ambassadors” for Christ (vs 20) and have a “ministry of reconciliation” (vs 18) – reconciling people to God. This is our mission

Apr 4, Thur

2 Cor 6: 1-13

Birthday: Chris Ann Rider

Paul appeals to the believers ... and implores them to “widen” their hearts (vs 12). In the list of hardships mentioned, notice the extent to which Paul would go to commend and encourage

Apr 5, Fri

2 Cor 6: 14-18

Pray for those who struggle with life issues – there’s a variety of it, that come in different forms and challenges

“Do not be unequally yoked” (vs14 f). What does this mean? Broadly speaking – be careful of relationships that entangle you unbelievers, unrighteous people. Cf. 7:1

2 Cor 7: 1-9

In response to Paul’s admonition letters, the “grieved into repenting” (vs 9 b) and so Paul is now comforted, and “overflowing with joy” (vs 4)
